This paper measures 8.5 inches wide and 11 inches tall (215.9 by 279.4 mm) and is most commonly used as home or office stationery in the United States, Canada, Chile, Mexico, the Dominican Republic, Costa Rica, Colombia, Venezuela, Chile, and the Philippines.

[To Print on A4 Size Paper](#)

This paper measures 210 millimetres wide x 297 millimetres tall (8.3 inches wide and 11.7 inches). It is the ISO standard and is commonly used by all countries except those listed above. [Information from Wikipedia.](#)
