

Printables: Return to Jerusalem-Rebuilding Walls



These printables can be used in a variety of ways, including illustrations for stories, cards to collect and match, bookmarks to take home and small pictures for attendance charts or matching games.

These should be printed on the correct paper size to look their best. The two most common sizes (“Letter” and “A4”) are provided here for each Bible Lesson.

To Print on Letter Size Paper

This paper measures 8.5 inches wide and 11 inches tall (215.9 by 279.4 mm) and is most commonly used as home or office stationery in the United States, Canada, Chile, Mexico, the Dominican Republic, Costa Rica, Colombia, Venezuela, Chile, and the Philippines.

To Print on A4 Size Paper

This paper measures 210 millimetres wide x 297 millimetres tall (8.3 inches wide and 11.7 inches). It is the ISO standard and is commonly used by all countries except those listed above. [Information from Wikipedia.](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/A4_paper)
