<b>Lesson Title:</b>	
<b>Scripture References:</b>	
<b>Emphasis or Theme:</b>	
<b>Welcome and Pre-class Activity:</b> <i>(Establishing rapport as children arrive through activities such as chatting, preparing items for class together, singing songs or praying.)</i>	
<b>Introducing the Story:</b> <i>(What you might say or do before the story to help create an interest or curiosity.)</i>	
<b>Telling the Story:</b> <i>(Outline the story here. Then describe the method you will use to tell the story. Examples might include showing pictures, drawing as you tell, using puppets, costumed characters, dramatic story-telling or any number of other methods.)</i>	
<b>Learning Activities:</b> <i>(Games, crafts, artwork, songs, memory verses or other activities that bring fuller meaning to the Scripture or make application to the lives of the students.)</i>	
<b>Review:</b> <i>(Solidify learning by repeating facts or themes or even the story itself through games, crafts, activities or visual aids.)</i>	
<b>Closing:</b> <i>(Prayer, last song...)</i>	
<b>Preparation:</b> <i>(What I need to do and items to gather before I begin to teach)</i>
