

## Bible Lesson Planner

<b>Lesson Title:</b>	
<b>Bible Verses:</b>	
<b>Theme:</b>	
<b>Welcome and First Activities:</b> Establish relationship with children as you gather. Have intentional conversation, sing, pray or prepare the meeting space together.	
<b>Introduce the Story:</b> What you might say or do before the story to help create interest or curiosity.	
<b>Tell the Story:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. First, read and study the Scripture (Bible verses) and then write a brief outline of the story and how you will tell it.</li> <li>2. Then, describe the method you will use to tell the story. Examples may include pictures, drawings, puppets, costumes, etc. Use a variety of methods over time.</li> </ol>	
<b>Reflection:</b> Include intentional questions, prayer and activities that allow children to connect with God and reflect on the story.	
<b>Activities:</b> Games, crafts, artwork, songs, memory verses, review or other activities that bring fuller meaning to the Scripture or make application to the lives of the children.	
<b>Conclusion:</b> Prayer, last song...	
<b>Preparation:</b> List items to gather before you meet. List tasks to complete.
