

## Bible Lesson Planner

<b>Lesson Title:</b>	
<b>Bible Verses:</b>	
<b>Theme:</b>	
<b>Welcome and First Activities:</b> Establish relationship with children as you gather. Have intentional conversation, sing, pray or prepare the meeting space together.	
<b>Introduce the Story:</b> What you might say or do before the story to help create interest or curiosity.	
<b>Tell the Story:</b>  1. First, read and study the Scripture (Bible verses) and then write a brief outline of the story and how you will tell it.  2. Then, describe the method you will use to tell the story. Examples may include pictures, drawings, puppets, costumes, etc. Use a variety of methods over time.	
<b>Reflection:</b> Include intentional questions, prayer and activities that allow children to connect with God and reflect on the story.	
<b>Activities:</b> Games, crafts, artwork, songs, memory verses, review or other activities that bring fuller meaning to the Scripture or make application to the lives of the children.	
<b>Conclusion:</b> Prayer, last song...	
<b>Preparation:</b> List items to gather before you meet. List tasks to complete.
