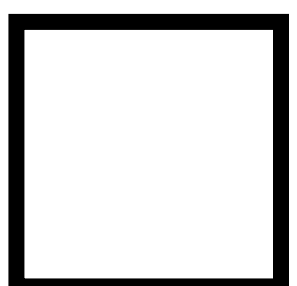
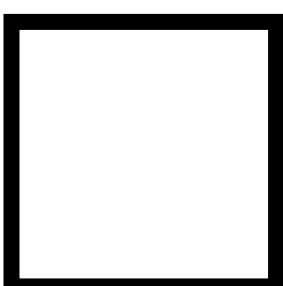
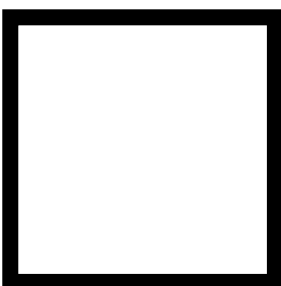
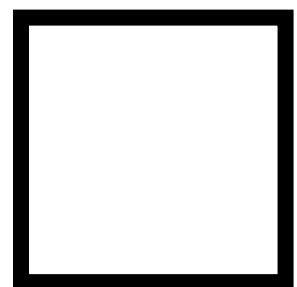
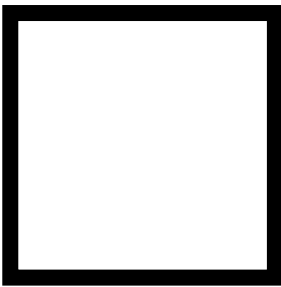
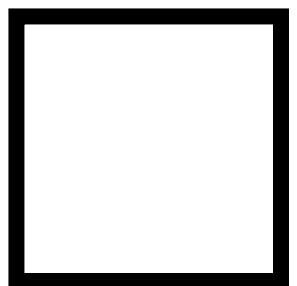
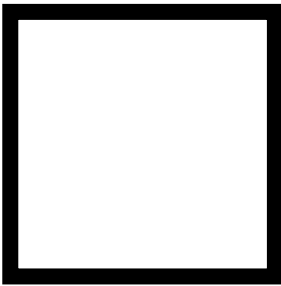
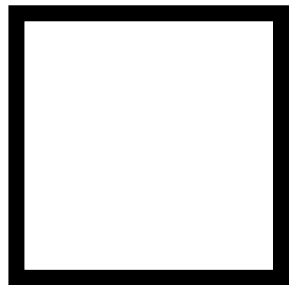
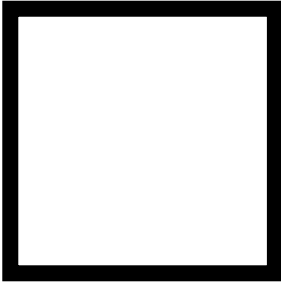


The Lord said to Moses, "Send men to explore the land of Canaan. I will give that land to the Israelites. Send one leader from each tribe."

These are the names of the men Moses sent to explore the land. (Moses gave Hoshea son of Nun the new name Joshua.)
